- Awards will be formally presented at NESASCC's annual barbeque on August 4, 2007 (attendance recommended but not required). All Eagles and Baiting Hollow Alumni are welcome to attend the BBQ – more information is available on our website, www.nesascc.org
- Only one application submission per scout is permitted.
